<b>Venue:</b>	Isola di San Servolo, Venice (Italy)
<b>Course fee:</b>	<b>€2,260</b> (includes teaching material, social programme, transfer from/to the airport to/from the island, boat to Venice, accommodation and meals)
<b>Travel:</b>	Participants are expected to make their own travel arrangements.
<b>Target audience:</b>	Participants will be senior to mid-level decision-makers in health policy and management at a regional, national or European level, with a limited number of places for more junior professionals.
<b>Applications:</b>	Applications by CV plus covering form (below) and a picture. Early applications are strongly encouraged as places are limited. The deadline for applications is <b>31 May 2018</b> . Successful applicants will be notified at the latest by <u>Friday, 15 June 2018</u> .
<b>Accreditation:</b>	The Summer School is generally accredited by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education. 2018 accreditation process is ongoing.

- National and regional policy-makers and senior civil servants who wish to enhance their understanding and application of the evidence, implementation and evaluation of person-centred strategies in different European settings.
- Those with a responsibility for the promotion of the generation, use and application of evidence to inform service delivery decision-making.

- Applications are welcome from all 53 WHO European Region Member States. If places allow, participants from outside the region will be considered.
